

VERO BEACH RBI IS DEVOTED TO BUILDING TEAM WORK

Our programs are designed to bring children together, teaching them the necessary social skills and behaviors that are required for life.







AFTER-SCHOOL AND SUMMER EXPOSURE, ENRICHMENT, AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

Designed as an academic and physical education program, **Fun At Bat**, focuses on giving children a healthy environment to stimulate academic growth and success, while strengthening positive character traits such as honesty, teamwork and responsibility. During the 2020 school year, **350** children participated in the Fun at Bat Program at seven elementary schools throughout Indian River County.

"I wish we did this every day and every week because I love the Fun at Bat program." – Shamon Thomas

The skills and educational coaching received, through the Fun At Bat program, resulted in an **85% increase** of improved behaviors and school attendance of underprivileged elementary students. The opportunity to strengthen their ability to read, understand math, participate in handson learning, all while being physically active made a difference. Fun at Bat fuses the sports of baseball, softball, and non-traditional sports with academics. This is a model works best in developing children physical, mental, social and emotional skills that are needed to navigate life.

Through our summer program, players have the opportunity to increase their success inside the classroom and learn how to respectfully interact with their peers and teachers.

77% of Fun at Bat Summer Program participants improved in the content areas of reading and 22% improved in the content area in math after the onset of a global pandemic during the summer of 2020.



88% Fun at Bat and RBI participants has performed on grade level and/or showed positive gains in their knowledge and self-awareness of positive behaviors and decisions.






